

# Meadowood Park Loop Hike - 1 Mile, Easy/Moderate

## How to Get There/Where to Start

Meadowood Park is located on Old Mill Road, 1.3 miles north of route 510 (Route 24). The entrance is on the western side (left) of the road between stone pillars.

### Trail Description

Meadowood Park Trail Loop is a great hike for families. The trail leads hikers through a variety of terrain including deep forest, stream, and field. There is a long, steep hill on the northwest part of the trail, down to Burnett Brook, so it is best to start uphill from the parking area and kiosk. Follow the paved path toward the entrance and head past the small gate up through the forest. Follow this trail through the small meadow to the trail at the edge of the forest. Alternately, follow the white blazes on posts. Follow the blazed trail downhill to Burnett Brook. Head along Burnett Brook until the path turns to the left uphill back to the parking area.
